Just when we thought normality had resumed COVID cases suddenly climbed and it was decided not to hold the usual Carols & Auction just before Christmas.

Our events in 2022 recommenced with a quiz in March, again very well supported, and thanks to quizmaster Kevin Nash. The Hundred once again catered for hungry quizzers at half time, again funded by the raffle proceeds.
