I mentioned last year how much people enjoyed a time to chat after services, helped by delicious cakes, chocolate brownies, biscuits, coffee tea and squash. Many thanks to Imogen who is the prime mover. Also many thanks to Imogen and Felicity for making sure the communion is prepared for the clergy.

The Church has always been involved in the social calendar in the village, and Eloise Hepple on behalf of the Red Lion Social Club organised an Easter Egg Hunt, ending up at the Church, just before one of our All Age Services. The congregation swelled enormously! Eloise organised the 2018 Easter Egg Hunt and a similar result happened.

Every year the Red Lion Social Club donates one third of the auction proceeds to the Church. This happened again for 2017, for which we are very grateful. In view of the legacy mentioned later in the report we asked if the Red Lion Social Club would like the money returned so it can be donated by them to another village organisation and they asked for this to happen.

We have received a legacy from the estate of Margaret Elizabeth Hales (nee Bunyan) who was baptised in the Church on 19th May 1929 and who lived on the South Coast. She is distantly related to the Ewers family, although we do not know which branch and also the Cherry family, where we have a similar problem. She also donated part of her estate to another Church.

We sent a letter around the village telling them of this good news and that the legacy should be able to pay for essential repairs to the Church building and provide some funds to modernise our equipment. The legacy, which is the principal reason for the very healthy balance in the accounts, will certainly be used up simply on these repairs and equipment improvements. We would have liked to install a kitchen and toilet facilities but these are not affordable.

I mentioned last year that we were hoping to have a Christmas tree planted in the Churchyard. Thanks to the Red Lion Social Club the tree was planted just before Christmas. Julian Chester kindly donated some 12 volt Christmas lights, so once again we have a village Christmas tree, but not yet as grand as the one previously in Molly Boughton's garden.

As always very many thanks to those who dedicate their time and effort in keeping the Church opened and maintained. Well over 50 different individuals have given their time and expertise to this end. Thank you all very much.

Finances

It costs about £9,000 per year to run the Church in Ashendon, excluding any repairs.

Our contribution to the Parish Share decreased slightly, a contribution of £1,000 was made toward the provision of superfast broadband to the village, £375 was given to local charities and we paid £247 for radio microphones to assist the congregation in hearing the readers.

The legacy from the estate of Margaret Elizabeth Hales totals £175,000, and there may be a little more to come when the estate is finally settled.

The net result for the year is an excess of receipts over payments of £176,085, so even without the legacy we would have has a surplus of over £1,000. Adding bank and deposit balances the balances carried forward as at 31st December 2017 totalled £216,910.
